March (First Stage)	Submit Application Form •Please make sure all documents required are in order prior to submission.
May / June (Second Stage)	Written Examination •Notification will be sent to successful candidates only.
July (Third Stage)	Interview
Aug (Fourth Stage)	Nomination (※) •Embassy will finalize candidates to be nominated to Japan.
Feb (next year)	Final Result – Notice of Acceptance from Japan

Postgraduate candidates should submit Letter of Acceptance (LOA) issued by universities in Japan to the Embassy by end of Sep.
