Submit completed application form and required documents to Embassy of Japan **strictly before 4:00pm on closing date.** For government servants, please submit to the Public Service Department of Malaysia.

APPLICATION PROCESS

**March
(First Stage)**

Submit Application Form

•Please make sure all documents required are in order prior to submission.

**May / June
(Second & Third Stage)**

Written Examination & Interview

•For undergraduate programme, only successful candidates who performed well in the written examination will be called for interview.

**Aug
(Fourth Stage)**

Nomination

•Postgraduate candidates should submit Letter of Acceptance (LOA) issued by Japanese universities to the Embassy by end of Sept.

Dec

Final Result

•Candidates get result of nomination – whether they are tentatively selected as scholarship recipients or not

Feb (next year)

University Placement Result

•Candidates get to know university placement result and confirmed as scholarship recipients.

LENGTH OF STUDY



Undergraduate (April Departure)

One (1) year of intensive
Japanese Language Course

PLUS

- Four (4) years University Course; **OR**
- Six (6) years University Course (for Medicine, Dentistry, Veterinary and Pharmacy)

Postgraduate (April / Oct Departure)

1½ or 2 years (maximum) in Non-Degree Research Study

※ Including six (6) months of intensive Japanese Language Course

ADMISSION (as regular course student)

- Duration can be extended to those permitted to enter Master's, Doctoral or Professional Graduate Course
 - Master's Course: Two (2) years
 - Doctoral Course: Three (3) years
 - Professional Graduate Degree: One (1) ~ Three (3) years
