rules and regulations 15km 5th. Malaysia International Ekiden Run 2010 Relay Marathon by 5 runners

- 1. Date: 16th. May, 2010 (Sunday)
- Venue: Putrajaya Corporation Complex opposite Istana Kehakiman (Palace of Justice) Jalan Perdana, Putrajaya
- 3. Start: 8.00am.
- Competition: This competition is organised according to MAAU and IAAF rules.
- 5. Route: The Start and Finish shall be at the Palace of Justice as per route map.
- Changing Zone: All exchanges of Sash / "Tasuki" are to be executed within the Changing Zone of 20m.
- 7. Team competition and age qualification
 - i. A team consist of five (5) runners. Running order of runners has

- to be submitted to the competition director during Numbers Collection days (Refer to Para 11).
- ii. All team runners must be 18 years and above except for Categories Men Junior and Women Junior who are between 13-17 years old.
- iii. Category "A" Mixed Team at least one runner should be of the opposite sex. The female runner can be a junior of the age of 13 years 17 years who can be absorbed into the team.
- iv. All prize winners' original Mykad or other validation document such as passport for foreigners will have to be produced on request of the Referee. Failing to produce the original Mykad or passport will result in disqualification of the team.
- v. Please be informed NO substitution is allowed after the submission of the runners list during Numbers Collection and teams changing the order of runners after confirmation and without the approval of the Meet Director will be disqualified.

8. Prizes

- The first five (5) teams in each category will be awarded with trophies.
- ii. All runners will receive finisher medals at the finishing point.
- Sash / "Tasuki"
 Every runner shall wear the Sash / "Tasuki" throughout the race.
