Development Issue 1-2 Response to Common Regional Issues in Asia Region	[Background and Current Situation] Malaysia is located beside the Straits of Malacca, an international maritime traffic hub. The efforts to ensure safety in the strait, strengthening counter-terrorism measures and combating smuggling and violent incidents will bring significant positive impact on trade and other economic activities in the ASEAN region as a whole. Furthermore, infectious diseases such as bird flu, new strains of influenza, dengue fever, Zika fever and COVID-19 are also common concerns in the region. Malaysia makes efforts to address those challenges in the region for its own economic development and to promote security and connectivity within the ASEAN region as a whole.			[Strategy] To enhance the benefit for the whole Asian region, Japan supports Malaysia' s efforts, including human resource development and the promotion of cooperation, in order to cope with common challenges in the Asian region such as improvement of ASEAN connectivity, promotion of the rule of law at sea and countermeasures against infectious diseases.
