JAPANESE GOVERNMENT (MONBUKAGAKUSHO: MEXT) SCHOLARSHIP FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2026

SPECIALIZED TRAINING COLLEGE STUDENTS

The Monbukagakusho:MEXT (Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Government of Japan) offers scholarships to Malaysian students who wish to study at Japanese universities as specialize training college students under the Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho) Scholarship Program for the academic year 2026. Applicants must be Malaysian citizens and meet the qualifications stated below:

1. FIELD OF STUDY

(A) Technology	(B) Personal Care and Nutrition	(C) Education and Welfare
(D) Business	(E) Fashion and Home Economics	(F) Culture and General Education

Choose preferred subjects from the Annex 'Majors and Related Subjects for Field of Study'. Applicants who choose 'Other Subjects' are required to specify the reason behind their choice. If there are no accepting colleges for the 'Other Subjects', his/her applications will be rejected and the applicants must withdraw from the scholarship selection.

2. TENURE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The tenure of scholarship is 3 years as from April 2026 inclusive of 1-year intensive Japanese language Course. The grantee who has graduated and been admitted for enrollment in Japanese university as a third-year transfer student and has outstanding academic achievement that meets certain criteria, he/she might have the extension of scholarship upon successful examination by MEXT.

3. QUALIFICATIONS

- Age: Applicants must be Malaysian passport holders' born on/after 2 April 2001. Applicants must have email and Malaysian address. Email is compulsory.
- Academic Background: Applicants must have completed SPM or UEC with at least eleven (11) years of formal education (excluding remove class). STPM students (lower or upper) and those who will sit for A-Level, Diploma, or Matriculation examination this year may also apply, provided that the results will be known by March 2026. Use your SPM result to apply.
- Academic requirement.

Japanese Language: Applicants must (be willing to) learn the Japanese language and (to) receive
education in the Japanese language.

4. ALLOWANCES

Estimated monthly allowances of **117**, **000 yen** (subject to change) will be given to each grantee during the term of his/her scholarship. Fees for the entrance examination, matriculation and tuition at universities will be exempted.

5. EXAMINATION

Only qualified applicants will be notified via **email** to sit for a written examination in Kuala Lumpur **tentatively in June 2025** (subject to change). Short-listed candidates will be called for an interview based on the results of the written examination.

- Educational Background: Please fill in ALL columns, DO NOT leave any column BLANK.
- Number of Submission: Only ONE (1) application per individual. Two applications will be disqualified immediately.
- Closing Date: Your application form must reach the Embassy of Japan <u>before 4:00 p.m.</u>
 9 April 2025 (Wednesday) to qualify. Late applications will not be considered.
